The Archdiocese of Detroit will be celebrating the Dr. Martin Luther King holiday by recognizing individuals and couples in the southeastern Michigan area who are continuing his work. The "Keep the Dream Alive" Award ceremony will take place on Monday, January 20, at Sacred Heart Major Seminary, 2701 Chicago Blvd., in Detroit, during a Mass celebrated by Bishop Moses Anderson at 11:00 a.m.

The leaders represent vicariates and Catholic Social Service agencies throughout urban and suburban regions. A vicariate is a geographical group of parishes that work together on common concerns.
