2010 March for Life

In 1974, a grassroots movement took place to lament the Supreme Court ruling of Roe v. Wade which legalized abortion in this country. That year, 20,000 people marched in Washington in defense of the unborn. The numbers have swelled as more than 300,000 marched this year on Friday, January 22, 2010.

The event includes a prayer vigil on the eve of the Roe v. Wade anniversary at the Basilica of the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception (pictured below). 1979 marked the first year of the vigil. Then, 50 people joined together to pray for an end to abortion. This year, nearly 20,000 people attended.

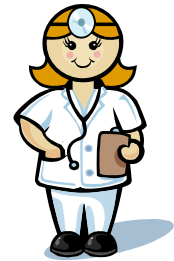
