Pill day!**

Join the American Life League for the third annual Protest the Pill Day! Get together with a group of friends or like-minded people outside your local pharmacy, Planned Parenthood or doctor's office- really, anywhere you can get the message out to others!

The American Life League website, www.thepillkills.com, which is promoting the Protest the Pill Day,

highlights the adverse side effects caused by the pill. Some of the side effects the website lists include cerebral hemorrhage, hypertension, pulmonary embolism (blockage of the main artery of the lung or one of its branches), arterial thromboembolism (blood clots in the heart), heart attack and cancer.

In addition to the information on the risk the pill poses to women, the website has an informative video showing how the pill kills babies. The video can be found under the "How the Pill Kills" tab- at the very top of the page.

The website also contains heartbreaking stories of women whose death has been linked to the pill as well as information on how "the pill kills the environment".

Educate yourself today on the dangers of the pill and plan a Protest the Pill Day with your friends on Saturday June 5th.



Divorce and NFP

The Family of the Americas Foundation posted the results of several surveys relating marital happiness to the use of NFP. Here are some of their findings.

NFP users:

- have a dramatically lower divorce rate (0.2%);
- experience happier marriages;
- are happier and more satisfied in their everyday lives;
- have considerably more marital relations;
- share a deeper intimacy with spouse than those who contracept;
- realize a deeper level of communication with spouse;
- have relatively large families with many children;
- are appreciably more religious and attend church more often;

- incorporate prayer more in their daily lives;
- rely strongly on the teachings of the Church, the Bible and God;
- have strong traditional, social and moral views;
- are unlikely to have ever had an abortion;
- are unlikely to have ever cohabitated;
- are unlikely to be supportive of and to engage in sex outside of marriage.
