

Fr. Robert Wyzgoski

Fr. Robert Wyzgoski died Dec. 30. He was 73.

Born May 3, 1933, to John J. and Agnes Wyzgoski, he was the fourth of five children. He was ordained June 6, 1959.

Fr. Wyzgoski was associate pastor at St. Benedict Parish in Waterford Township from 1959 to 1961; Our Lady Queen of Peace Parish in Harper Woods from 1961 to 1966; and St. Christopher Parish in Detroit from 1966 to 1972. He then was pastor at St. Suzanne/Our Lady Gate of Heaven Parish in Detroit from 1972 to 1984; St. Veronica Parish in Eastpointe from 1984 to 1996; and Our Lady Queen of Martyrs Parish in Beverly Hills from 1996 to 2002.

Under the provisions of the Charter for the Protection of Children and Young People (Dallas Charter) he resigned as pastor and was granted senior priest status on June 24, 2002.

Fr. Wyzgoski is survived by his sisters Joan and Evelyn, 17 nieces and nephews, and great nieces and nephews. He was predeceased by a sister, Lorraine, and brother, Bernard.

He was to have been waked from 2 p.m. until 9 p.m. on Jan. 4 at A.J. Desmond & Sons Funeral Home, 2600 Crooks Road in Troy. He will lay in state from 10 to 11 a.m. on Jan. 5 at Our Lady Queen of Martyrs Parish, 32340 Pierce St. in Beverly Hills. His funeral Mass will begin at 11 a.m. Burial will follow in Holy Sepulchre Cemetery in Southfield.
