Cardinal Maida Ordains 8 Permanent Deacons

Cardinal Adam Maida, archbishop of Detroit, ordained eight men to the permanent diaconate in a ceremony Saturday morning, October 2, at Detroit's Blessed Sacrament Cathedral.

Permanent Deacons are ordained to a life of service in the ministry of the Church. They are called to bring a special sensitivity in ministering to the needs of the family; to single parents; to students; the aged; the sick; the imprisoned; the chemically dependent; the poor and the alienated.
