Cardinal Adam Maida, archbishop of Detroit, will ordain three men to the Catholic priesthood at 10 a.m. on Saturday, June 3, at Blessed Sacrament Cathedral, 9844 Woodward Avenue, Detroit.

Charles Fox, Don LaCuesta, and Hoang Lam, will be ordained. They will greet family and friends following their ordination at a reception on the cathedral grounds.

**Charles Fox, 29, of Redford** is the son of Chuck and Rosemary Fox of Redford. His home parish is St. Valentine, Redford. He holds a B.A. in Communications from the University of Michigan-Dearborn and worked briefly as a newspaper journalist before entering the seminary. Fr. Fox will celebrate Masses of Thanksgiving at noon on June 4 at St. Valentine, Redford; 6 p.m. on June 10 at St. Joan of Arc, St. Clair Shores; and noon on June 11 at Immaculate Conception, Anchorville.
