

Biography of Fr. Stephen C. Boguslawski, OP

The Very Reverend Fr. Stephen C. Boguslawski, OP, is a native of Waterbury, Connecticut. He assumed the rectorship and presidency of the Archdiocese of Detroit's Sacred Heart Major Seminary in 2003, after the departure of then-rector Bishop Allen Vigneron to the Diocese of Oakland. Father had previously served the seminary as Dean of Studies since 2001. Before his tenure at the seminary, he served for three years as vice president and academic dean of the Dominican House of Studies, Washington, D.C.

Father Boguslawski was ordained to the priesthood in 1987, and has been a professed member of the Order of Preachers—the Dominicans—since 1981. He holds a number of higher-level degrees, including two master's degrees and a PhD from Yale University, and an STB and STL from the Dominican House of Studies. He is currently on the executive committee of the Midwest Association of Theological Schools and a member of the board of advisors of the English edition of the international theological journal *Nova et Vetera*.
