



TWO-HOUR ASBESTOS AWARENESS TRAINING

The USEPA Asbestos Hazard Emergency Response Act (AHERA) requires school districts to identify and manage asbestos containing materials in their buildings. A key component in effective asbestos management is training. AHERA requires at least two hours of initial asbestos awareness training with refresher training each year thereafter. This rule applies to **maintenance, custodial staff, and cleaning companies** who may work in a building that contains asbestos.

The asbestos awareness training class will cover the following topics:

- Information regarding asbestos and its various forms and uses.
- Information on the health effects associated with asbestos exposure.
- Locations of asbestos containing building materials in each building.
- Recognition of damage and deterioration of asbestos.
- Contact information and availability of management plans.

This Awareness Training class will meet the requirements for both the initial training of first-time participants and for refresher training of individuals who attended a previous class.
