Dear Brothers in Christ:

Father Joseph A. Triano, SSP, entered eternal life September 9, 2007, at the age of 79. May he be at peace with the Lord he loved so well.

Father Triano was born in Mt. Vernon, NY, on July 4, 1928. He entered the Society of St. Paul at Staten Island, NY, on August 28, 1949, and was ordained in Canfield, OH, on September 9, 1952. Over the years, he served the Society of St. Paul in many capacities.

From 1969-1980, Fr. Triano served two terms as Provincial Superior of the United States Province. In 1980, he transferred to the Society of St. Paul Community in Dearborn. For the next 27 years, he served the community in a variety of capacities, while assisting at St. Sebastian Parish, Dearborn Heights, and also at St. Cyril of Jerusalem Parish, Taylor.

Father Triano will be waked at the St. Sebastian Parish Hall, 20710 Colgate, Dearborn Heights, on Monday and Tuesday, September 10 and 11, from 2 until 9 p.m. There will be a Rosary on Tuesday at 7:30 p.m. (*Howe-Peterson Funeral Home, Dearborn, 313-561-1500, is handling the arrangements.*)

Father Triano's body will lie in state at St. Alphonsus Church, 13540 Gould, Dearborn, beginning at 9 a.m. on Wednesday, September 12, until the celebration of his funeral Mass at 10 a.m. Burial will take place at St. Paul Cemetery, Canfield, OH.
