Holy Week and Easter Programs on the Catholic Television Network of Detroit

The Catholic Television Network of Detroit (CTND) is presenting a variety of special programs during Holy Week and Easter. CTND is carried by Comcast, Brighthouse, and Wyandotte Cable to over 900,000 households throughout the Archdiocese of Detroit. Chrism Mass

Thursday, April 5, CTND will carry this Mass live at 3:30 a.m. with Pope Benedict XVI from Rome. During the Mass, the Holy Father will consecrate the Chrism and bless the Oil of the Sick and the Oil of the Catechumens. Chrism is used in baptism, confirmation, and ordination.

Mass of the Lord's Supper

Thursday, April 5, CTND will broadcast this Mass live at 11:30 a.m. with Pope Benedict XVI from Rome. During the Mass, the Holy Father will wash the feet of 12 people to commemorate Christ washing the feet of the 12 apostles at the Last Supper. The Mass will be repeated at 12 a.m. on Friday, April 6.

In addition, CTND will carry the Mass of the Lord's Supper live at 5:30 p.m. with Choral Meditations from the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Washington, D.C.

Way of the Cross

Friday, April 6, CTND will carry Pope Benedict XVI following in the footsteps of Christ. This program will be pre-taped in the Coliseum in Rome and air at 8 p.m.

Lord's Passion

Friday, April 6, CTND will carry the commemoration of the Lord's Passion live at 11 a.m. with Pope Benedict XVI from the Vatican. The program will be repeated on Saturday, April 7, at 12 a.m.

In addition, CTND will broadcast the Franciscan Missionaries of the Eternal Word's commemoration of the Lord's Passion live at 4 p.m.

Easter Vigil Mass

Saturday, April 7, CTND will broadcast this Mass live at 4 p.m. with Pope Benedict XVI. The Mass will be repeated on Sunday, April 8, at 12 a.m.

In addition, CTND will carry the Easter Vigil Mass live at 8 p.m. from the National Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Washington, D.C.

Easter Sunday Mass

Sunday, April 8, CTND will broadcast this Mass live at 4:30 a.m. with Pope Benedict XVI. The Mass will be repeated at 12 p.m.

In addition, CTND will carry Easter Sunday Mass live at 8 a.m. with the Franciscan Missionaries of the Eternal Word. It will be repeated at 11 p.m.

Cardinal Adam Maida, archbishop of Detroit, will celebrate the Easter Sunday Mass for Shut-Ins on CTND at 6 p.m. In addition, this Mass will air on WJBK-Fox 2 at 6 a.m.

Urbi et Orbi (Easter Message and Blessing)

Sunday, April 8, Pope Benedict XVI's Easter Message and Blessing to the City of Rome and the World will be broadcast live at 6 a.m. and repeated at 1:30 p.m.
