## Pledge Agreement

### Overview

The Fishermen's Fund was created to ensure that Seminarians and Lay Persons not allow financial hardship to prevent them from following their decision to serve the Church, *in the Archdiocese of Detroit*. The fund is intended to be actively used, and, therefore, it is anticipated that numerous awards from the fund may be made during the school year. Recipients of awards from the Fishermen's Fund will be asked to sign a pledge (below) indicating their commitment to the Church and also requesting them to pay back the awarded funds should their vocation plans change.
